2024 Hillclimb Supplemental Rules

Rider Participation:

All riders participating in the event must be registered with District 16 if required by the following points:

1) All participants living within the District 16 boundaries must be a member of the AMA and possess or purchase a current District 16 membership card. Verification is the responsibility of the hosting club/promoter.

2) Clubs and promoters holding competitive events shown on the AMA District 16 schedule, points and non-points paying, not verifying and selling District 16 Registration cards will be considered in violation of the rule 1. Clubs / promoters accepting seven or more event riders without District 16 cards will pay a \$100 fee for each event/day. An additional \$10 per rider will be charged for the eighth such rider entry, and each additional rule-2 violation entry at this event. Excessive violation of this rule may also place future event scheduling in jeopardy, as determined by the District 16 board.

The AMA racing Rule Book applies to all AMA District 16 organized events.

There will be a finish line marker at the top of each hill and a finish line umpire will be there also.

Riders may enter six classes: Class designations and the preferred order of the day are:

65cc	6-11yrs. 0-65cc 2-stroke or 0-90cc 4-stroke maximum wheel size 14 inches
Mini Jr.	7-11yrs. 52-85cc 2-stroke or 52-125cc 4-stroke maximum of 16 in. rear wheel size and 19 in. front.
Mini Sr.	12-15yrs. 66-85cc 2-stroke or 75-125 4-stroke maximum wheel size 16 inch rear and 19 inch front.
Super Mini	10-15yrs. 99-112cc 2-stroke 99-150cc 4-stroke with 16 inch rear and 19 inch front wheels
125	113cc-125cc
200	126-200cc 2-stroke/126-250cc 4-stroke
250	201-250cc
450	251-450cc
600	451-600cc
750	601-750cc
Open	751cc and up
Masters	40 years and over/any engine size
Vet	50 years and over/any engine size
Women	Female riders at least 12 years of age on any motorcycle or minicycle with an engine displacing at least 86cc.

4 Stroke 113cc-Open riders at least 12 years of age
2 Stroke 113cc-Open riders at least 12 years of age
400 Stock 113cc-400cc
Open Stock 401cc-Open

King of the Hill (KOTH) 113cc and above engine size.

The King of the Hill class is comprised of only the ten (10) fastest riders of the day (no substitutions). For this class, points will be awarded by rider and not by qualifying class. Riders who qualify in the top ten from more than one class must ride the machine they had their best qualifying ride on. Recommendation: King of the hill runs at the end of day. The riders name, class, and qualifying time to be announced with the riding order, starting with 10th place working to first place if need be.

A rider must participate in a minimum of 50% of the scheduled District 16 meets in his/her discipline to be eligible for a year-end award.

POINT SYSTEM.

The following point system will be used for each event to determine final point standings for the District Annual Awards:

The clubs and promoters will have a long handled round point shovel, with a 9.25" by 11.5" blade, and a 48" handle at the starting line for the riders' use.

Note: District Director does not have to pay any fees to race or enter the event.
